

## Expression of Interest

### Joint Privacy Disclosure Statement

#### 1. Collection of your personal information – Energy Masters Expression of Interest

We (Department for Energy and Mining, SA Power Networks, RACE for 2030 Ltd, University of South Australia, University of New South Wales, and University of Technology Sydney) collect, maintain, use and disclose your Personal Information in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles and Privacy Act 1988, including, where appropriate and possible, explaining to you why we are collecting the information and how we plan to use it.

#### 2. Consent, use and disclosure of your personal information

- a. By completing and submitting your Expression of Interest to the Department for Energy and Mining, you consent to us collecting your Personal Information.
- b. The types of personal information we may collect include your name, contact details, national metering identifier (NMI), energy use data, and information relating to the current Consumer Energy Resources\* installed at your property (Personal Information). Please note that in the case of energy use data and information relating to current Consumer Energy Resources installed at your property, SA Power Networks may collect this data from you or access it from the existing customer database that SA Power Networks holds.
- c. We will collect, hold, use and disclose your Personal Information for the following purposes:
  - i. To consider your eligibility for participation in Energy Masters;
  - ii. To consider whether you will be selected to complete an application for participation in Energy Masters;
  - iii. To respond to your enquiries or feedback;
  - iv. If your expression of interest is successful and you are selected to complete an application, to disclose your Personal Information to MAC Energy Efficiency Group Pty Ltd trading as MAC Trade Services for the purposes of MAC Trade Services creating an online application link.

#### 3. Third Parties

We will ordinarily only collect your Personal Information from you. However, in some circumstances, we may be given information by third parties. In that case, we will take reasonable steps to ensure that you are made aware of the information that was provided to us by the third party.

#### 4. Accessing your personal information

We will endeavour to keep your Personal Information accurate and up to date.
